- 2 Strawberries, two punnets, any other variety
- 3 Lemons, on tray, one layer, thin skinned and juicy
- 4 Lemons, on tray, one layer, any other variety
- 5 Apricots, six, on 20cm plate
- 6 Nectarine, six, on 20cm plate
- 7 Peaches, six, on 20cm plate
- 8 Passion fruit, six, on 20cm plate
- 9 Mulberries, on 20cm plate
- 10 Avocados, three, any variety, on 20cm plate
- 11 Any other fruit in season, on 20cm plate
- 12 Any other berry in season, on 20cm plate
- 13 Nuts, any variety, on 20cm plate
